The course for the Master introductory module (S11) currently only takes place in the winter semester. You can therefore only attend this course in the following semester - please consider this to be compulsory, otherwise you will not be able to progress in your degree programme.

You can focus on the PRE courses in this semester. Please attend those courses you are required to pass as part of your degree programme admission in the first semester(s). You cannot attend certain modules without passing the PRE courses. You do not all have the same PRE courses as a requirement, please refer to your letter of admission.

For S12 courses pre-courses in Introduction to Religious Studies and Theories and Approaches need to be completed (!!!), therefore these courses are not listed in the timetable. If you do not have to fulfil these requirements, you can register for the courses as normal via eCampus.

From the various R-Modules (R11/R12/R13) and language Courses (Module C) you can choose more or less freely. Please note that some of these R-courses require relevant prior knowledge in the corresponding area of religious history. For more information on the different modules and the total number of courses, please refer to the module handbook and the to-do list. All of these documents can be found on the CERES website under Study Programme - Documents.
